Parents/guardians leaving their children before or after such sessions retain responsibility even in their absence.

## **Rules and Code of Conduct**

1. Players and Parents must fill in a signing on form and a parental consent form.
2. Remember South Reading players are ambassadors for their club.
3. At no time will South Reading players fight or argue between themselves or others.
4. Any player who does not pay subs for 1 month will be suspended from playing until subs are up to date. (Unless an agreement has been reached with the club explaining why the subs are unpaid). The manager will return his/her registration card to the secretary until the suspension is completed.
5. Players are personally responsible for any fines/administration fees levied against them by any League or Football Association.
6. Any player who does not pay fines/administration fees levied against him/her will be suspended from playing until the fines/administration fee is paid. The manager will return his/her registration card to the secretary until the suspension is completed.
7. Players must inform their managers as soon as possible if they are unable to play on match day.
8. Players are responsible for their own belongings, i.e. tracksuits, jumpers etc.
9. Whilst waiting for their training session (i.e. Leisure Centre) they must wait outside the courts until those using them prior to the training have left the courts.
10. Any player found misbehaving at football training will be sent off the field for five minutes.
11. Players whose parents have transport are asked to attend and support their child as much as possible.  
Parents that require others to provide transport for their son/daughter are asked to contribute towards running costs.
12. Players using other parents transport must:
  - Remove football boots, soiled and/or wet clothing
  - Sit down and not stand on seats
  - Always wear a seat belt (where fitted)
  - Do not litter the car
- Any player found damaging the car will be held responsible and will pay for all damages.
13. Players must wear kit provided by the club, not different colour socks, shirts, shorts etc.
14. Players must wear shin pads at all matches and training sessions.
15. Players must tuck their shirts into their shorts at all times while participating in a match.
16. Players must always play to the Referees whistle and never argue with the Referee.
17. Teams will not wait for a player if they are more than 10 minutes late on match days.
18. If a player is injured during a match or training and is sent to hospital the club Chairman or Secretary must be informed for insurance purposes.
19. No arguing with team managers. The manager's decision is final.
20. All jewellery must be removed for matches and training. (FA Rule)
21. Players and parents must abide by the Club codes of conduct, child protection and equality policy set out by the Club.
